

Campbell Tailgating Policy and Registration Form 2010

Tailgating at university games is a time-honored tradition. Nothing could be better than gathering with family and friends before home football games. Campbell's new stadium is a beautiful setting for college football. Following is a list of rules for tailgating during the 2010 season.

A Tailgating Registration form is needed only for those who need an area for cooking (open flame) or additional space outside of normal parking space area.

FAMILY FRIENDLY

Tailgating at Campbell is a family friendly environment. Please be respectful of those surrounding you with your choice of language and volume of music. Groups are personally responsible for making sure their guests act appropriately.

OPEN

Fans may enter the parking area as early as four hours before game time.

CLEAN UP

All parties are responsible for making sure their assigned tailgating area is cleaned prior to departing for the game. All trash/recyclable items must be picked up and deposited in proper receptacles. Trash should be in bags or trash containers. Tailgating spaces not completely cleaned prior to kick-off could result in the loss of future tailgating privileges.

BEVERAGES

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on University property.

FOOD/GRILLING

Grilling is permitted in the tailgating area. All grills must be elevated. Catered events must be arranged through ARAMARK (CU Food Services). No outside vendors are allowed without approval by the University. Charcoal and grease dumps will be provided by the University. Locations will be marked by signs.

Rowdy, threatening or inconsiderate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in ejection, arrest and/or loss of ticket privileges for future athletic events.

REGISTRATION

Students, faculty, staff, parents, alumni groups and friends of the University may reserve spaces for tailgating as follows:

1. Spaces are on a first come, first serve basis.
2. Registration for these spaces is either by season pass or game day pass with a 5 day advance notice to the University.
3. Pass holders must keep parking pass visible at all times on vehicle.
4. Spaces may be limited by the volume of request for permits to tailgate.
5. All cost of tailgating areas are set by the University.
